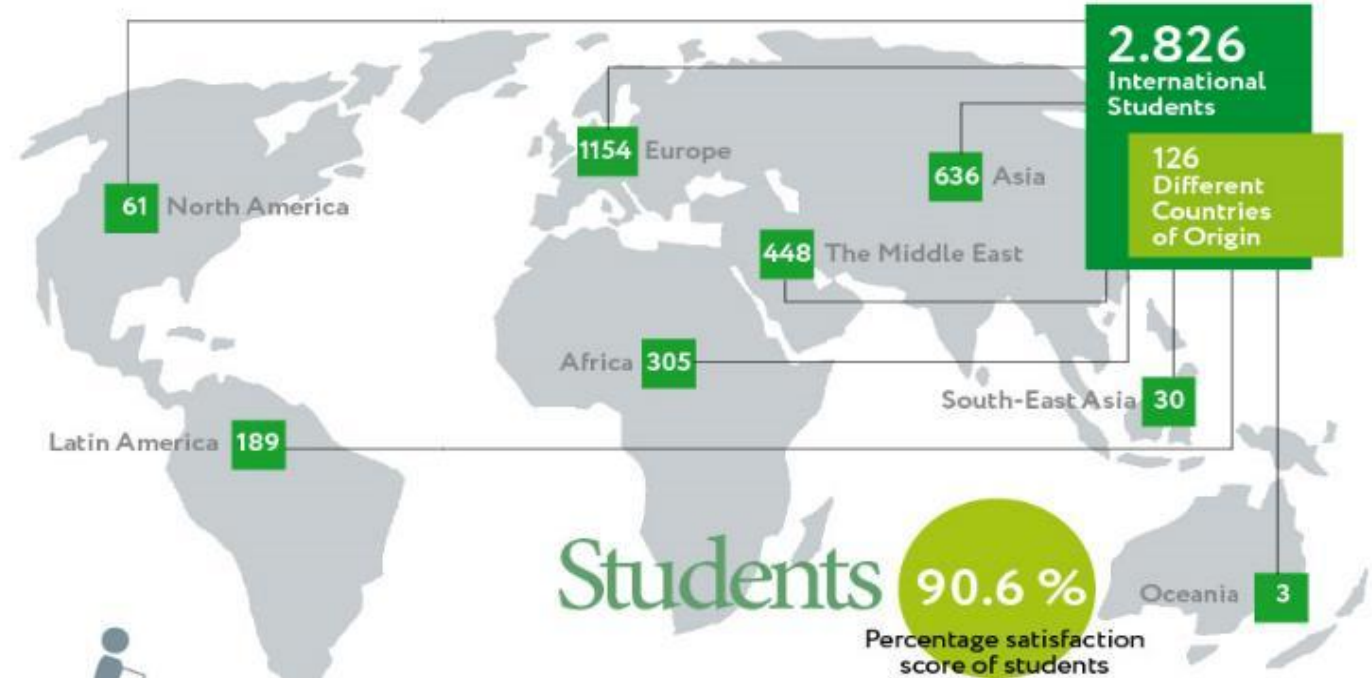
World University Ranking 2025

In the overall **QS** World University Ranking 2025, Tor Vergata University has significantly improved its position, rising to **393rd** place globally (up from 489th) and **12th** in Italy (previously 14th).

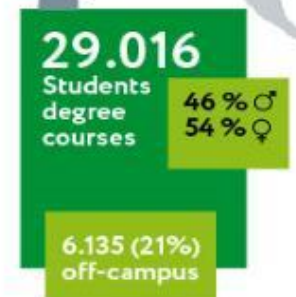
The Times Higher Education (**THE**) 2025 ranking, just released we are **2°** in Italy for **Internationalisation**. Roma Tor Vergata has moved from **3°** to **2°** place in Italy compared to the previous year. It is first in this sector among public universities in Rome.

Foundation Course

It is a propaedeutic course, intended for foreign final titles obtained with less than 12 years of schooling or for which students do not have the requirements prescribed by Italian law.

The foundation course will be held in Italian for courses taught in Italian language and in English for English-taught degree courses.

During the foundation course the University organises Italian and English language courses with the aim to enhance your level. Furthermore history and Italian culture courses will be offered.

The one year foundation course is designed to provide students with new skills needed to approach the admission tests.

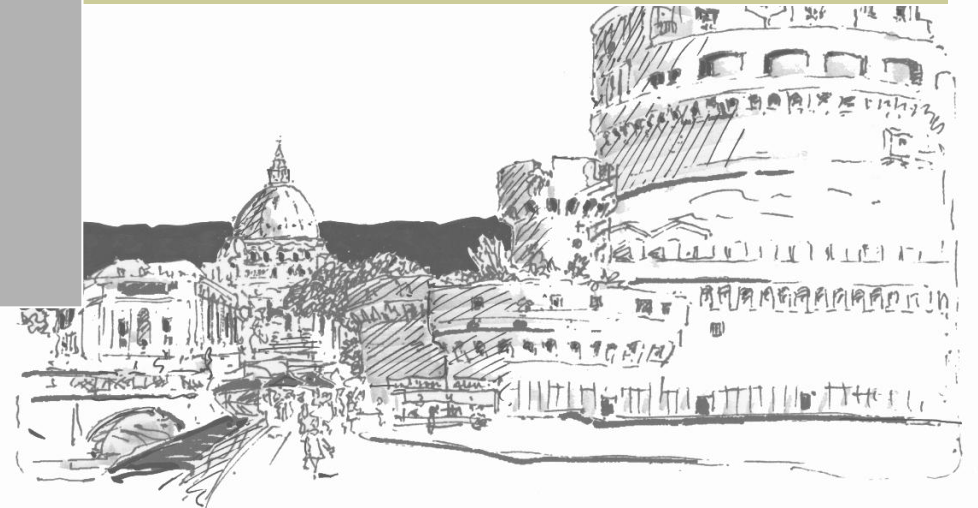

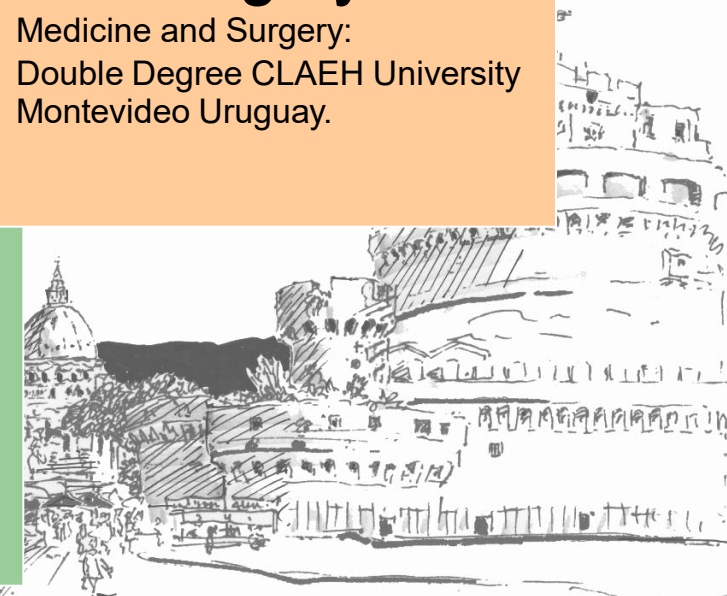

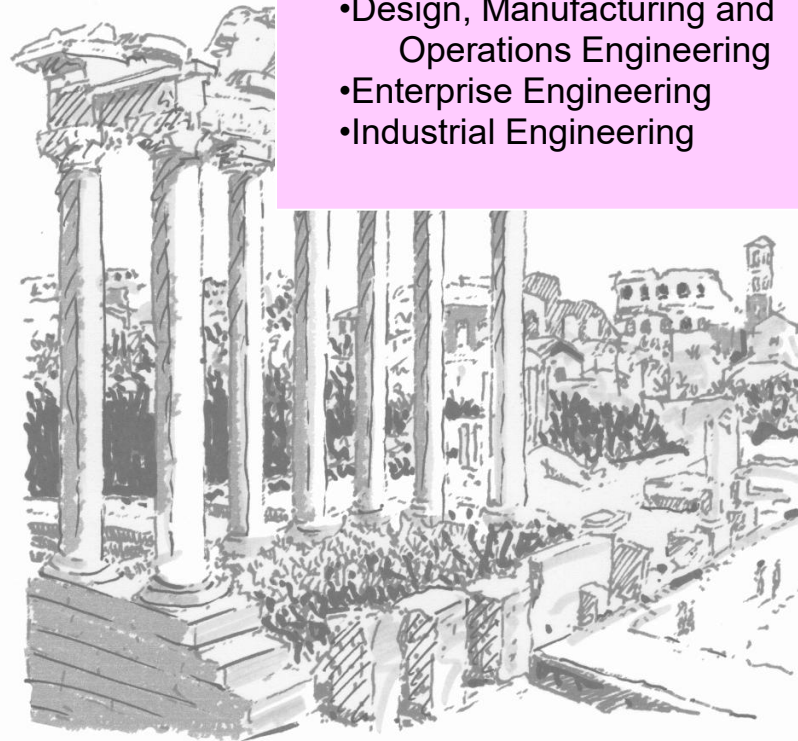
